Methods Help Others; Play Games

Preparation Time

Location Indoors or Outdoors

You will need:

- Flip chart
- Pen
- · Football and improvised goal posts
- Oranges

Activity Instructions:

- Label four walls/areas; Kingdom, King Arthur, Camelot and castle. The Beaver Scouts stand in the middle of the playing area.
- 2. When the leader calls out a command e.g. 'Kingdom' the Beaver Scouts run to that wall/area.
- 3. Additional commands could be:
 - a. Sir Lancelot Beaver Scouts imitate a Knight riding on horse back
 - b. Damsel in distress Beaver Scouts gently lift up the Beaver Scout next to them (if they can!)
 - c. Round Table Beaver Scouts form a circle
 - d. Hail King Arthur Beaver Scouts take a bow.

- always to flee treason
- To by no means be cruel but to give mercy unto him who asks for mercy
- To always do ladies, gentlewomen and widows succour
